Entry Form: Postmarked by April 1st 2010 (must have verification signature)

Qualifications: Youth ages 9 to 19 in 4-H Archery project. Leader/Parent Category

Rules:

- NO HORSEPLAY !!! (See Code of Conduct)
- Direction of arrow will always be kept within suitable zone of fire towards target.
- 4-H Archery Range Rules and Procedure (Instructors manual)
- Whistle and verbal commands (Instructors manual)
- Proper method of arrow removal from target (Instructors manual)

Range setup: Modified FITA with a variety of shooting distances. Distance is measured from the shooting line to the target bottom as rested on the ground. Target may be left on the ground or raised to any point not to exceed 4 feet off the ground.

Age groups: Junior (9-10), Intermediate (11-13), Senior (14-19) Age requirements - at least nine years old or in the 4th grade by December 31st of the program year. Leader/parent categories - must be currently registered/approved 4-H leaders/parents.

Category: Recurve and Compound bows with 3 distances each. You may enter as many as you wish.

Prizes: Awards to top shooters in each division and bow category.

A. Archery Match Event

Scoring: FITA target 10-ring scoring method will apply. Center ring is 10 points with every ring outside the center losing one point until the last ring is 1 point. Arrows hit on a line will score the higher point. If the arrow lands in the center "X" ring, mark the score card as "X" and count as 10 points. In the event of a tie, the most x's will win.

Age divisions and distance of target:

Age Division (as of 1/1/10)	Distance in yards
Junior (9-10)	7.5-short, 10-mid, 15-long
Intermediate (11-13)	10-short, 15-mid, 20-long
Senior (14-19)	15-short, 20-mid, 25-long
Leader	30-short, 35-mid, 40-long
Parent	25-short, 30-mid, 35-long

Shooting requirements: Each participant will shoot a total of 3 arrows per round with 10 rounds per scorecard. There will be one scorecard for each distance. Each scorecard must be started and finished in one shooting session.

B. Equipment requirements and limitations for 2010 Archery Match

Recurve bows and arrows may be provided, or you may use your own. Safety equipment (arm guards and finger tabs) are required. The judges will perform a safety check on all equipment being used in the competition to assure it is safe to use. Recurve and Compound bows will compete in separate categories.

Equipment standard:

- **Recurve** Kisser button, torque compensator permitted. No string peep sights or mechanical releases permitted.
- **Compound:** Mechanical release or release aids, torque compensator permitted. Maximum draw weight of 60 pounds.
- **Arrows:** Must match bow being used for length and strength. Wooden arrows will not be permitted for use in compound bows. No hunting, broadheads, or expandable points are permitted.

C. Judging-Project leaders are to judge or appoint suitable judges.

- The judges will conduct the scoring for each participant using the FITA target 10 ring scoring method.
- The determination by the judges will be final.
- The judges have the right to disqualify a participant for unsafe or disorderly conduct.
- The judges have the right to prevent unsafe equipment from being used in the competition.

D. Targets, Scorecards, and Returning

- One target for every three persons.
- Targets will be sent to each club's archery leader after all entries are received. (You may purchase additional targets if you wish.) Scorecards will be labeled with participant's name and categories entered.
- The scorecards must be postmarked back to the Pleasant Hill 4-H club by June 1st 2010. Please return **ONLY** the scorecards, **NOT** the targets.
- The project leader must sign the bottom of the scorecard verifying the accuracy of scoring and that all rules were followed.
